Non-Verbal Reasoning usually turns up for one or two questions in the girls' maths paper. Also there will be girls who are training for other exams that include Non-Verbal Reasoning.

Exam Technique Classes are all the same, so one should be enough unless we are seeing repeated problems thrown up in the Mock Exams.

CEM, GL Papers ???

South Wilts Grammar School has been using GL Assessment for years (GL stands for Granada Learning, formerly National Foundation for Educational Research- NFER). The exam will be 3 papers of Maths, English and Verbal Reasoning.

Bishop Wordsworth School started using CEM (Centre for Evaluation and Monitoring, Durham University) in 2015. The exam will be two papers containing a combination of Maths, English, Verbal Reasoning and Non-Verbal Reasoning.

Both exams are multiple-choice and are held at the relevant Grammar School in mid to late September.

GL provide sample papers (for a price), CEM do not. However Amazon is awash with books with

“CEM” stamped all over and it is only when you have read the very small print inside a dark corner that you discover that they have no affiliation with CEM at all.

Whatever the exam provider (many schools write their own) the exam will always be based on the National Curriculum, Key Stage 2, plus a bit of Non-Verbal Reasoning and maybe an essay (always check; these things frequently change). The children will not be asked to give an account of the discussions between Socrates and Aristotle and their influence on Plato.

Whether you use the folders I provide for free or buy The Scholar’s Course books you will cover all you need. There will always be things you are unfamiliar with but the more practice you do the fewer there will be and the more coping strategies you will have.

My pass rate is the same for boys and girls.
