“Ooohh, that’s lovely wrapping paper” said Mary. “Take it off carefully, I can use it again next year”.

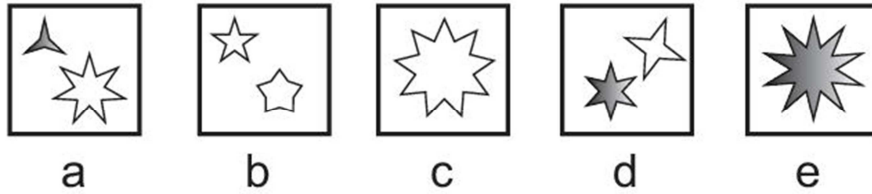

“Anyway,” interrupted Balthazar, “we should really be off now. Lovely to meet you, sorry about the shameless product placement...”

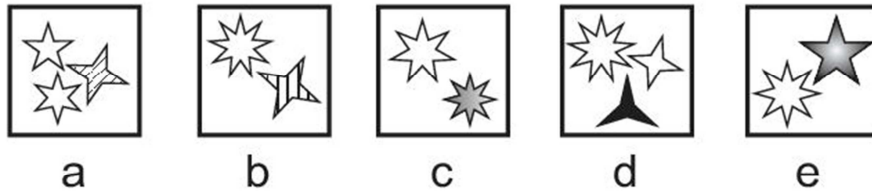
And being warned of God in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed into their own country another way.

“Well, that was a super journey” said Balthazar as they left Bethlehem. “But let’s go the short way back”.

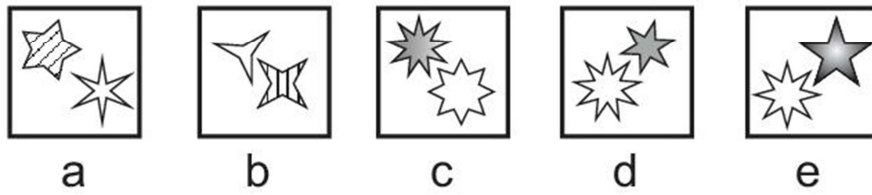

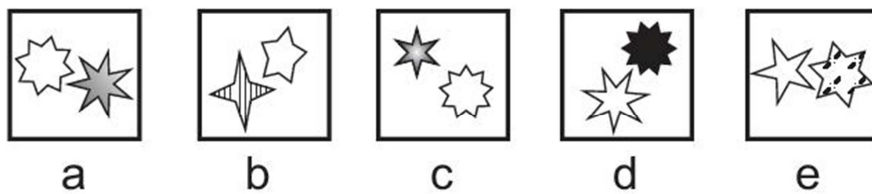
